- g) Who is Waris Shah?
- h) What is the historical background of Amrita Pritam's 'I say unto Waris Shah'?
- i) Why was the narrator left with Begum Jaan for a week?
- j) Why does Rabbu have to leave Begum Jaan temporarily?
- k) What charge is levied against Benare in Tendulkar's play?
- l) Who among the characters in 'Silence, the Court is in Session' is a lawyer in real life?
- m) Who was raised and supported by the Kashikars?
- n) What happened to Harbart's books after his death?
- o) Name the organization that exposed Harbart's business as a sham.
