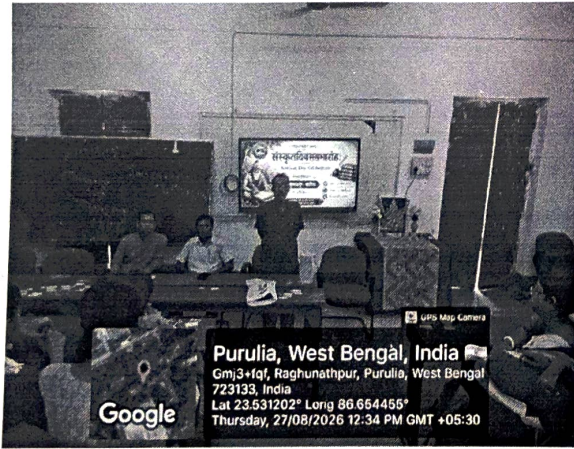


REPORT ON SANSKRIT DAY CELEBRATION
